### Artichoke-Green Globe

Botanical: *Cynara scolymus*  
Days to harvest: Slow crop

Globe shaped green fruit with purplish base. Productive and good tasting.



### Asian Stir Fry-Mix

Botanical: *Various*  
Days to harvest: From 40-55

Fast growing seasonally adjusted mix of 6 Asian leafy greens. All ready in 6 to 8 weeks from sowing.



### Beans-Broad Aquadulce

Botanical: *Vicia faba*  
Days to harvest: 75

Cool weather crop, plant autumn and winter. Flowers purple and white, pods are mid green, 15 x 3cm. Plants are 90-100cm tall.



### Beans-Bush

Botanical: *Phaseolus vulgaris var. nanus*  
Days to harvest: 55

This high yielding bushy plant produces dark green 12 to 15cm plump straight pods with white seeds.



### Beans-Climbing

Botanical: *Phaseolus vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 70

Long straight stringless beans, dark green skin. Very vigorous under full sun in warm climates. Long harvest time.



### Beans-Kentucky Wonder

Botanical: *Phaseolus vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 70

Tall climbing variety with oval, thick, gently curved pods.



### Beans-Royal Burgundy

Botanical: *Phaseolus vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 70

Purple bush bean with green foliage and purple flowers and pods 15cm long.



### Beans-Strike

Botanical: *Phaseolus vulgaris var. nanus*  
Days to harvest: 45

Dwarf bushes grow to 30-55-cm. Widely adaptable with heavy yields. Pod size is 15cm and pod colour is green.



### Beetroot-Bulls Blood

Botanical: *Beta vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 35

Blood red beets can be harvested for leaves, baby beets or left until fully grown.



### Beetroot-Early Wonder

Botanical: *Beta vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 60

Mid maturing hybrid with strong tops well suited to bunching. Good uniformity colour and flavour.



### Broccoli-Armada

Botanical: *Brassica oleraceae*  
Days to harvest: 70-80

Produces firm medium sized semi domed heads. These are followed by a good yield of side shoots, for multiple harvest. Produces from Spring to Autumn.



### Broccoli-Atomic

Botanical: *Brassica oleraceae*  
Days to harvest: 80

Suited for cooler conditions. Summer, autumn harvest. Dark green head with fine bead.



### Broccoli-Baby Bunching

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Sweet flavour, less fibrous than broccoli. Pick out main stem at 55 days to encourage shooting. Repeat picking, grown all year.



### Broccoli-Green Sprouting

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 85

An old favourite. Autumn, winter production. Large, vigorous, will grow up to 80cm heads.



### Broccoli-Greenbelt

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Early to mid-season type. Attractive tight round heads on well shaped crowns. Spring-summer planting.



### Broccoli-Marathon

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80-90

Mid to late season type. Quality deep green heads for cool season production. Reliable industry standard. Summer-autumn planting.



### Broccoli-Purple Sprouting

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 85

Harvest in late winter and early spring. Produces many small deep purple heads. Good in stir fries or steamed.



### Broccoli-Romanesco

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 85

Heirloom variety - a mix of broccoli and cauliflower. Excellent taste. Lime green colour heads, pick while heads are tight.



### Broccoli-Summer

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Upright plant, single heads with a few side shoots. Suit summer production. Grows to 60cm high with a head size of 300grams.



### Broccoli-Winter

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 85

Winter harvest. Upright plant has fine beads and is large. Slower maturing, variety is tolerant to hollow stem.



### Brussel Sprouts-Long Island

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Harvest sprouts from bottom up as heads mature. A rich source of many vitamins and minerals.



### Cabbage-Green Coronet

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 100-110

An adaptable variety with excellent holding ability. Flattened globe of medium green colour and 4-5kg in size. Suits all year round.



### Cabbage-Green

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 90

Green leaved cabbage with an oval shaped head to 3kg. Sweet taste. Suitable for summer, autumn and winter production.



### Cabbage-Mini Red

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 88

Only 1kg in weight, a small red cabbage rounded in shape with a small core. Suits all year round.



**Cabbage-Mini White**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 88

Only 1kg in weight. A small, white rounded cabbage with a small core. Suits all year round production.



**Cabbage-Ruby Perfection**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Larger head 1.6kg. Plant is uniform with good colour. All year.



**Cabbage-Savoy**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 90

Crinkly leaf type. Plants are large and spreading with dark green crinkled leaves. Excellent eating, good in coleslaw. Strong flavour.



**Cabbage-Savoy King Hybrid**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 90

An F1 savoy type. Grow in spring, summer, autumn. Large head, heavy yield, deep green crinkled leaves.



**Cabbage-Sugarloaf**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Pointed cabbage, semi erect type. Head weighs 1.5kg. Good tolerance to cracking. Sweet taste.



**Cabbage-Sugarloaf OP**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Small compact plant, light green leaves with 15-20cm long pointed heads at around 1kg. Early spring production.



**Carrot-Little Fingers Baby**

Botanical: *Daucus carota*  
Days to harvest: 50-60

French heirloom variety, suitable for heavy soils. Short, broad deep red orange roots. Sweet tasting.



**Carrot-Parisian Round**

Botanical: *Daucus carota*  
Days to harvest: 85

Parisian type, round and sweet. 3 to 5cm



**Carrot-Purple**

Botanical: *Daucus carota*  
Days to harvest: 60

Deep purple, with an orange centre. Very attractive and with a good sweet carrot taste.



**Capsicum-Aji Rico**

Botanical: *Capsicum baccatum*  
Days to harvest: 70-75

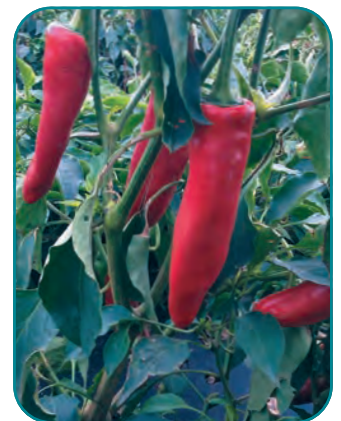
Has more plant vigour, higher yield and earlier ripening than other O.P. heirloom types. Loads of taste. Wide range of uses.



**Capsicum-Big Bertha**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 72

Large 3-4 lobed, thick walled fruit. Reaches 18x10cm on a compact plant. Turns green to red and is tobacco mosaic virus tolerant.



**Capsicum-Bullhorn Red**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Long, slightly curved tapering to a blunt point. Fruit is 20 x 4 cm, green turning to red at maturity. Sweet in flavour, may be used for stuffing.



**Capsicum-California Wonder**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 75

An old time favourite sweet green capsicum. Vigorous plant with bell shaped fruit reaching a size of 11x 10cm.



**Capsicum-Candy Cane Red**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 60-65

Elongated bell shaped 9-10cm long fruit. Ripens from green and white stripes to solid red. Thin walled and crispy texture. Indeterminate habit ideal in a container or ground.



**Capsicum-Cubanelle**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Fruit green to waxy yellow to red, banana type. 18cm x 4 cm Sweet and mildly pungent taste.



**Capsicum-Cute Stuff Gold**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 60

Apple shaped, mini-bell capsicum, fruit matures from green to gold. Crunchy flesh and a sweet, summery flavour. Heavy yields.



**Capsicum-Fooled You**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 65

Distinctive jalapeno type without the pungent heat. High yields of thick walled fruit 8 x 4.5cm that resemble jalapenos. Fruit turns from green to red.



**Capsicum-Hungarian Sweet Wax**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Sweet capsicum with a mild flavour and a long, tapered yellow fruit.



**Capsicum-Long Sweet Yellow**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70-80

Hungarian yellow wax type with long tapered fruit that turn from yellow to red. Very sweet and mild flavour.



**Capsicum-Mad Hatter**

Botanical: *Capsicum baccatum*  
Days to harvest: 70-90

Flattened disc shaped fruit, is crunchy and has a delicate floral scent and rich flavour that intensifies and sweetens as it matures.



**Capsicum-Mariachi F1**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Fruits turn green to yellow to red and may be picked yellow with no loss of heat or flavour. Plants are compact, 45-60cm high. Heavy yield.



**Capsicum-Mini Bell Red**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 80

Small bell fruit 5 x 3cm. Fruit starts out as green and matures to red. Strong plants, good protective leaf cover. Produces all summer.



**Capsicum-Mini Bell Yellow**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 80

Small bell fruit 5 x 3cm. Fruit starts out as green and matures to yellow. Strong plants, good protective leaf cover. Produces all summer.



**Capsicum-Mohawk F1**

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 75

Spreading-cascading habit that is good for hanging baskets. Green to orange 10-13cm long fruit are sweet.



### Capsicum-Pimento Elite

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 73

Sweet, thick walled fruit that reaches 7 x 9cm, turning from green to red. High yields.



### Capsicum-Redskin

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 75

Upright, compact plant. Heavy fruiter of 10 x 6cm in size, going from green to red. Has good holding ability. Ideal for container growing.



### Capsicum-Snack Red

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 105-120

Neat and compact sweet capsicum with many 3.5 x 6cm fruit. Excellent outdoor performance.



### Capsicum-Snack Orange

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 105-120

Neat and compact sweet capsicum with many 3.5 x 6cm fruit. Excellent outdoor performance.



### Capsicum-Snack Yellow

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 105-120

Neat and compact sweet capsicum with many 3.5 x 6cm fruit. Excellent outdoor performance.



### Capsicum-Sunbell

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Very sweet 4 lobed, bell type fruit that turns from green to yellow.



### Capsicum-Sweet Mix

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Mixture of Yolo Wonder and Long Sweet Yellow. Sweet tasting varieties.



### Capsicum-Sweet Cherry

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 85

Round, sweet tasting fruit that is 4 x 5cm. Fruit turns green to red at maturity.



### Capsicum-Yolo Wonder

Botanical: *Capsicum annuum*  
Days to harvest: 72-75

Bell shaped robust, disease resistant variety. High yields of sweet large fruits that mature to a deep red. Fruit walls are thick, sweet and crunchy.



### Cauliflower-All Year Round

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 60

Smooth pure white, hybrid heads of 10-15cm are produced on medium sized plants. Best grown Feb-Sept.



### Cauliflower-Highway Star

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

This variety maintains its attractive purple colour, even after cooking. May be grown all year round. Has full tight heads.



### Cauliflower-Mini White

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 60

A small headed variety. Suited for year round production.





**Cauliflower-Waikata F1**

Botanical: *Brassica oleracea*  
Days to harvest: 80

Early to mid season type. Attractive tight heads on well shaped heads. Suit a spring-summer planting.



**Celery-Hornet**

Botanical: *Apium graveolens*  
Days to harvest: 60-65

High yielding branching type. Medium dark-green colour can be harvested in winter and autumn.



**Celery-Peppermint Stick**

Botanical: *Apium graveolens*  
Days to harvest: 90

Striped pink and green stalks. Intense, full flavour with abundant yields. Very slow to bolt. Has a long harvest period.



**Celery-Utah**

Botanical: *Apium graveolens*  
Days to harvest: 60

Good vigour and uniformity. Medium dark green colour with excellent bunch shape. Grow in cool conditions for autumn harvest. Grown all year round.



**Chard-Rainbow**

Botanical: *Beta vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 55-60

Unique colours with striped and standard red & white stems. Mild chard flavour, tender bronze dark green leaves.



**Chard-Swiss Peppermint**

Botanical: *Beta vulgaris*  
Days to harvest: 55-60

Pink and white chard, topped with forest-green leaves packed with nutrition and flavour. The ideal edible ornamental.



**Chilli-Acapulco Multicolour**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 85-95

Neat, compact ornamental chilli, many multicoloured 1.5 x 4cm fruit. Ideal table top pot.



**Chilli-Acapulco Purple**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 85-95

Neat, compact ornamental chilli, many multicoloured 1.5 x 4cm fruit. Ideal table top pot.



**Chilli-Apache**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 70

Attractive dwarf chilli bush, upright habit. High yield of 7cm long pointed fruit turning from green to red. Fruit are hot in flavour with a long shelf life.



**Chilli-Big Chilli**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 68

A mild flavoured, Anaheim chilli that gets to 20-25cm long. Ripens from green to red.



**Chilli-Birds Eye Hot**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 80

Plants are big, tough and very cold tolerant. Small tapering fruit 4.5 x 8cm going from green to red. The fruits are very hot and ideal in Asian cuisine.



**Chilli-Dragon Roll Pepper**

Botanical: *Capsicum annum*  
Days to harvest: 67

Fruits are 8-13cm, carry a mild heat when young but top out at about 200 Scovilles, making them more mild than a jalapeño pepper, but provide some heat.

Naturally dwarf, non-stretching salvia. Produces a large number of dense, bright coloured blooms. Day length neutral and performs well in the garden.



**Salvia-Salvatore**

**Botanical:** *Salvia nemorosa*  
**Colours:** Blue

Features the largest spikes and the deepest coloured calyx. Black stems on well branched plants. Heat tolerant and good ground cover.



**Salvia-Summer Jewels**

**Botanical:** *Salvia coccinea*  
**Colours:** Lavender, Pink, Red, White

Exceptional branching habit, with a multitude of flower spikes. Plants produce an abundance of blooms all summer which attract pollinators. Excellent uniformity within the series.



**Salvia-Vista**

**Botanical:** *Salvia splendens*  
**Colours:** Burgundy, Lavender, Purple Red & White, Red, Rose, Salmon, White, Mix  
 Dense spikes, dark green foliage, hold their colour all season. Vista can finish 2-5 days after other commercial series depending on light conditions, but have better outdoor performance.



**Sedum-Lizard**

A low-growing sedum that has tight, rosy-green cushion of needles with reddish tips. In summer the plant is covered with many tiny, star-shaped white flowers.



**Sedum-Oracle**

Low growing to a height of 15-20cm, spread 20-25cm. Yellow flowers in summer. Hardy-copes with temperatures down to around minus 34°C. Durable, long-lived and perfect for hot sunny locations.

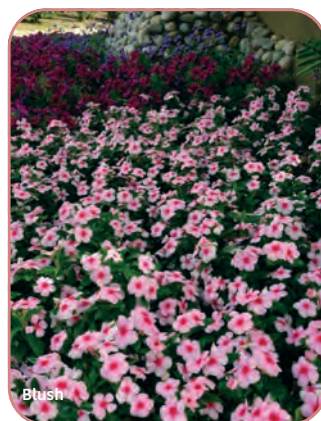

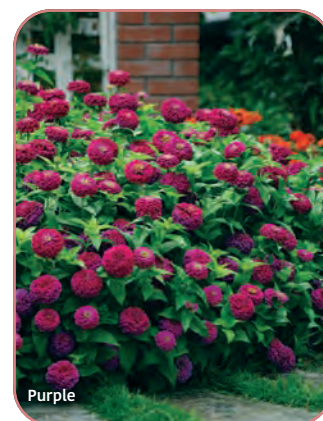
