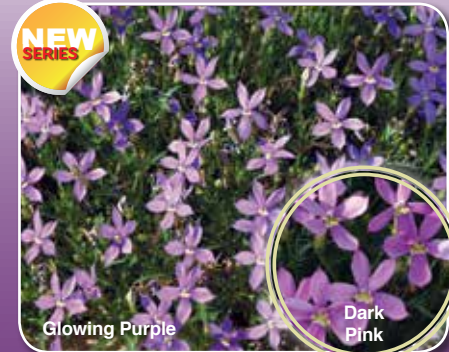

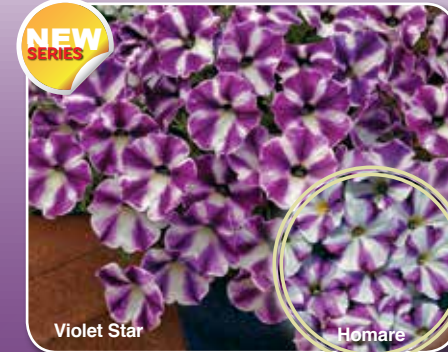

**Artichoke-Green Globe**

**Botanical:** Cynara scolymus  
**Days to harvest:** Slow crop  
 Globe shaped green fruit with purplish base. Productive and good tasting.



**Asian Stir Fry-Mix**

**Botanical:** Various  
**Days to harvest:** From 6 weeks  
 Fast growing seasonally adjusted mix of 6 Asian leafy greens. All ready in 6 to 8 weeks from sowing.



**Chard-Rainbow**

**Botanical:** Beta vulgaris  
**Days to harvest:** From 6 weeks  
 Unique colours with striped and standard red & white stems. Mild chard flavour, tender bronze or dark green leaves.



**Chard-Swiss Peppermint**

**Botanical:** Beta vulgaris  
**Days to harvest:** From 6 weeks  
 Eye catching pink striped stems. High garden and ornamental value.



**Sweetcorn-Gold**

**Botanical:** Zea mays  
**Days to harvest:** 60 to 80  
 Old style sweetcorn with excellent taste. Produces 20cm kernels with great flavour and a bright golden colour.



**Eggplant-Bonica**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 60 to 70  
 High yielding, shiny, purple fruit on a strong plant.



**Eggplant-Fairy Tales**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 50  
 Long lavender fruit with white stripes. Produced in clusters of 3-5. Sweet fruit best harvested at the gourmet baby stage. Ideal in patio containers and small gardens.



**Eggplant-Little Fingers**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 68  
 An abundance of slim, long, dark purple fruit. Grows 15-20cm in three to six per cluster. Spineless plants make picking easy.



**Cucumber-Bush Crop**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 60  
 Ideal for small gardens, fruit 15 to 20cm long x 5 to 6cm diameter. Will not require a pollinator plant.



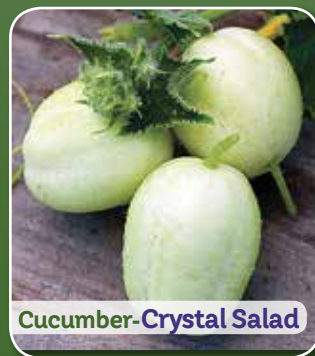
**Cucumber-Bush Pickles**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 48  
 Compact, straight cylindrical fruit, 10-13cm long, 3cm in diameter. Monoecious will not require a pollinator plant.



**Cucumber-Burpless Op**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 55  
 Light green with white spines. Slight block shape 10-30cm long. Flesh is tender, ideal slicer or pickler. Good disease resistance.



**Cucumber-Crystal Salad**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 60  
 Rounded cream to white smooth skinned fruit which has an excellent flavour.



**Eggplant-Market Supreme**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 110  
 Adaptable variety suited to all growing areas. Fruit size is 16cm x 11cm, teardrop in shape with a glossy black skin.



**Eggplant-Mini Lebanese**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 70  
 Compact plants suitable for patio containers or small gardens. Good flavour and high yielding fruit.



**Eggplant-Patio Baby**

**Botanical:** Solanum melongena  
**Days to harvest:** 60  
 Compact plants produce baby sized 5-7cm long x 2.5cm diameter fruits early and often. Easy grow, easy harvest. Ideal for patio planters and small gardens.



**Capsicum-Big Bertha**

**Botanical:** Capsicum annum  
**Days to harvest:** 72  
 Produces thick, crisp fruit, extremely sweet. Mature from dark green to shiny red. Perfect for stuffing and in salads.



**Cucumber-Lebanese**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 55  
 A 13-15cm deep green fruit with good flavour.



**Cucumber-Patio Snacker**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 53  
 Controlled, vigorous variety dark green skinned fruit. Spread: 90cm-1.5m. Short, branching vines. Suit small gardens, large pots with a small trellis. High yielding. Fruit: 4cm x 20cm.



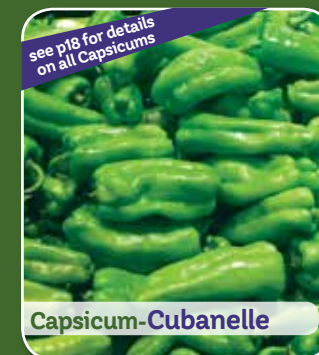
**Cucumber-Tasty Green**

**Botanical:** Cucumis sativus  
**Days to harvest:** 50  
 Early, heavy yielding burpless type. Tolerant and resistant to downy mildew. Fruit 20cm x 6cm. Monoecious will not require a pollinator plant.



**Sweetcorn-Bicolour**

**Botanical:** Zea mays  
**Days to harvest:** 60 to 80  
 Bicolour variety of Supersweet corn. Very sweet cobs, to 20cm with white and yellow kernels. Good disease resistance and plants grow to 180-200cm.



**Capsicum-Cubanelle**

**Botanical:** Capsicum annum  
**Days to harvest:** 70  
 Known as a sweet pepper with a slight simmer of heat to it's flavour. Light yellowish-green colour when unripe, will turn bright red if allowed to ripen.



**Capsicum-Sweet Red Cherry**

**Botanical:** Capsicum annum  
**Days to harvest:** 58  
 A sweet heirloom variety, dark green to dark brownish red. Round shape and slightly pointed. Thick walled. Slightly sweet and tart. Good for pickles, sauces, fresh, grilled, fried or roasted.



**Chilli-Big Chilli**

**Botanical:** Cucumis  
**Days to harvest:** 68  
 A mild flavoured, anaheim chilli that gets to 20-25cm long. Ripens from green to red.



**Chilli-Habanero Mix**

**Botanical:** Capsicum annum  
**Days to harvest:** 60 to 80  
 Hot and spicy! Lantern shaped fruit vary in size, ripen to mature colours of Chocolate, Mustard, Orange, Peach, Red, White and Yellow. Good for pots.

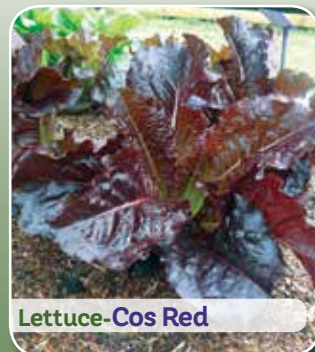


**Lettuce-Butterhead Red**

**Botanical:** Lactuca sativus
