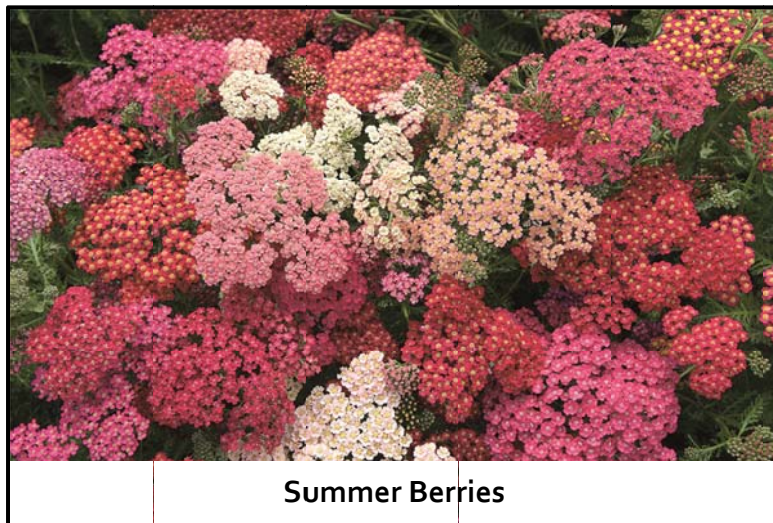




# Achillea F2 Flowerburst Red Shades & Summer series

*Achillea millefolium*



COLORS AVAILABLE:	Flowerburst Red Shades, Summer Berries, Summer Pastels
FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE:	Hardy perennial, USDA Zone 3-9, 24 – 30 inches/61-76 cm in height
NOVELTY CHARACTERISTIC:	Stands up to wind, drought, heat and humidity, blooming tirelessly through the summer
MARKET USE::	Attracts butterflies and beneficial insects, good cut flower, drought tolerant landscaping
	<b><u>CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:</u></b>
CONTAINER SIZE:	
	SOWING: 200 or larger
	FINISH CONTAINER: 6" pot, gallon container
PLUG STAGE:	
	GERMINATION 10-15 days / 65 – 70° F/18-21°C / light
	EC (POUR THRU METHOD) 5.8-6.2 pH <0.5 EC
	PLUG FINISH TIME: 6 – 8 weeks
FINISHING:	
	TRANSPLANT: One per quart, one per gallon
	DAYS TO FLOWER: May to November
	TEMPERATURE: Night- 45-55°F/7-13°C; Day 55-60°F/13-16°C
	EC: 1.0-1.2 mS/cm
	pH: 5.8-6.2
GARDEN::	Full sun, suitable for xeroscaping, perennial borders, flowers very freely even in poor and dry soils once established.

**NOTES:**

- Sowings made from late October to early December can be ready for blooming sales from April to June
- Sowings made in February will produce salable green packs (32 cells per flat) in about 9 weeks at 50°F / 10°C night temperature.
