Agastache x hybrida



COLORS AVAILABLE: Sandstone, Sun, Sunset

FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE: Height 8 – 10", Width 8 – 10"

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Compact and uniform. Extremely floriferous with little care once established.

MARKET USE: First year flowering, drought tolerant perennial

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 288 cell tray

FINISH CONTAINER: Quart and gallon pots

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 5-7 days / 68-72°F; cover lightly

EC (POUR THRU METHOD): Emergence to cotyledon expansion = <0.5 mS/cm

cotyledon expansion to true leaf growth = <0.75 mS/cm;

plug finish EC = 0.75-1.2 mS/cm

PLUG FINISH TIME: 4-5 weeks in a 288 tray

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 28-35 days after sowing

DAYS TO FLOWER FROM Long Days: 13-15 weeks

SOWING: Short Days: 17-20 weeks

TEMPERATURE: 60-70°F day / 55-60°F night

EC: 1.5 – 2.0 mS/cm (pour thru method)

pH: 6.4-7.5

GARDEN: Planting distance: 10-12" off center, dry, sunny location

NOTES:

- Agastache will exhibit chlorosis if media pH is below 6.2
- Agastache will not tolerate wet conditions in the garden
