







Bred by the team at Kings Park Botanical Gardens WA led by Digby Growns, Kings Park Royale exhibits unique purple/red flowers with a warm orange/red base. This variety is a colour breakthrough with flower colours never before seen in Kangaroo Paw.

Kings Park Royale is a short lived perennial that is well suited to tub and pot displays. It has so much to offer gardeners-longlasting bursts of colour on a neat plant that will attract birds to the garden and add interest to all garden styles.

This variety will perform best in a dry climate in well drained soil. Flowers may fade in direct sunlight.

KEY NOTES/ATTRIBUTES	Short-lived variety, purple/red flowers with a warm orange/red base.

HABIT	Dwarf habit with unbranched stems
MAINTENANCE	Remove dead stems and cut old flowering stems back to their base to encourage repeat flowering.
SEASONAL CLIMATE ZONE	Zones 3 to 4
RECOMMENDED POT/PLUG RATIO	1 plug per 140-175mm pot
FLOWERING PERIOD	Late winter to early summer
GROWING MEDIA PH RANGE	pH 6.0-6.5. Well drained soil
WATERING	Avoid over watering especially when plants are young. Increase watering as plants come into flower.
FERTILISER	Good quality controlled-release fertiliser is suitable.
PESTS & DISEASES	Snails and slugs are most common. Kangaroo paw can be affected by rust or ink spot disease. Remove any badly affected leaves.
FINISHING TIMES	In 140mm pot, 12-16 weeks
LIGHT REQUIREMENT	Full sun

- Produced by tissue culture under ultra-hygenic conditions to enusre disease-free and consistently high plant quality.
- · Very tough nature. Low maintenance and reliable plants.
- · Ideal for cut flower production, gardens and pots.
