Chrysanthemum paludosum



COLORS AVAILABLE: White with yellow center

FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE: Height: 8 – 10 inches, width: 8 – 10 inches, attractive daisy-like blooms in profusion

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Annual, compact plants provide a tremendous show of flowers throughout the growing

season. Flowers are 1.5 inches across, larger than other paludosum Chrysanthemums

MARKET USE: Excellent bedding plant, spring sales, great in mixed containers

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 288 - 512 or plug tray

FINISH CONTAINER: 4 - 6" pots, mixed containers

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 10-14 days / 60-65°F; cover seed lightly

EC (POUR THRU METHOD): Emergence to cotyledon expansion = <0.7 mS/cm - 0.9 mS/cm

cotyledon expansion to plug finish = <1.0 mS/cm

PLUG FINISH TIME: 4—6 weeks in a 288 tray

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 30-35 days after sowing

DAYS TO FLOWER FROM

SOWING: 65-75 days

TEMPERATURE: 60-70°F day / 45 - 60°F night

EC: 2.0 - 3.5 mS/cm (pour thru method)

pH: 5.7—6.4

NOTES:

Finishing in packs will take about 10-11 weeks (sow to sell)
