Gomphrena globosa



COLORS AVAILABLE: Bicolor Rose, Pink, Purple Red, White

FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE: Height: 20" - 24" outdoors 30"-36" indoors/Basal branching/Annual

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Heat tolerant; excellent dried flower

MARKET USE: Cut flowers, dried flowers, tall bedding, excellent gallon item

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

SOWING: Spring, early summer

FINISHING: Summer, fall

PHOTOPERIODISM: None

PLUG STAGE:

TRAY SIZE: 512-288, 200

GERMINATION: Emergence 5 - 10 days / 75-80°F; cover seed lightly

EC (POUR THRU METHOD): Emergence to cotyledon expansion = <0.7 Ms/cm - 0.9 Ms/cm

cotyledon expansion to plug finish = <1.0 Ms/cm

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Not required

PLUG FINISH TIME: 3—5 weeks

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 20-30 days after sowing

SPACING: 10" x 10"

DAYS TO FLOWER FROM

SOWING: 70-90 days

TEMPERATURE: For best quality days over 75°F day / nights over 55°F

COMMON DISEASE/PESTS: Botrytis/Thrips, aphids

NOTES:

- Semi clean seed count is 470 seeds/gram
- Transplant as soon as seedlings can be handled
- Grow on warm and on the dry side
- Withstands humid southern summers
- If grown indoors support netting will be necessary
