

## Heuchera Palace Purple

(*Heuchera micrantha*)

Perennials Culture (revised 11/01/23)

**Plug crop time:** 6 to 8 weeks

**Transplant to finish:** 10 to 12 weeks

- Compact variety has highly attractive foliage of strong bronze-purple, with small white flowers appearing later.

**Foliage height:** 10 in./25 cm

**Flower height:** 20 in./51 cm

### Vernalisation

### Propagation Key Tips

During Stage 1, maintain media moisture at level 4 and RH at 80%. Saturated level 5 media moisture and reduced or fluctuating humidity in Stage 1 can decrease germination and uniformity. Upon removal from germination chamber, place in propagation house with bottom heat at 65-68°F/18-20°C media temperature. Use light mist to maintain humidity, allowing media to dry to moisture level 3.5 and mist at level 3. Maintain under mist for up to 3 weeks as this variety germinates slowly in 2 to 3 flushes. Spray fungicide to prevent damping off. For forcing info: See Perennials Forcing Guide.

### Fertiliser Notation

Fertilize every other irrigation with 15-0-15 at 150 to 200 ppm nitrogen. Maintain medium electrical conductivity around 1.0 mmhos/cm (using 1:2 extraction).

### Common Problems

Insect: Leaf Nematodes Disease: Powdery Mildew, Botrytis, Leafspot, Rust, Root Rot

### Finishing Key Tips

Do not plant plugs too deep. Keep plug surface at the same level as the media surface. Grow relatively dry. Needs well-drained medium.
