Common Name : Trailing lithodora

General Information : Stunning true blue flowers complement silvery foliage.

Its low-growing habit makes it ideal at garden's edge, as a ground cover, in rock gardens and cascading over stone walls.

Idea & Tips : Grow in full sun, well drained, sandy soil, occasional watering when established.

Grower Information : Low-growing, trailing habit with glossy green, mat-forming leaves and intense blue flowers at the ends of lateral stems in early Spring.

Daylength : Lithodora **Grace Ward** will bloom naturally as days lengthen and temperatures begin to rise in late Spring.

Cool Treatment :

Plant Maturity: Cold treatment is not required.

Plant Growth Regulators : Generally not needed.
