Vegetative

Garden Height and Width

25-35 cm tall and 30-35 cm wide.

Soil

Ideal pH is 6.0-6.3 and EC is 0.9-1.8mS/cm (Highest EC allowance is 2.0mS/cm).

Use the disease free soil or media for bedding plants available in your area.

Weeks to Harvest from Planting

24 weeks

Example crop schedule for a 10.5mmpot

Aug. to Sep. Plant plugs into a container

Feb. to May. Ready to sell out

Flowering

Spring (Feb. to Apr.)

Container Size

105 mm to 240 mm

Temperature Day/Night

20'C/10'C(Day/Night) is ideal. Keep the temeperature below 30'C to prevent drooping.

Light

Day extension lighting is not necessary.

Fertility

Begin fertilization at 100 ppm nitrogen when roots become visible. After roots developed well, rates can be increased up to 200 ppm nitrogen.

Supplemental feeding with additional iron will help prevent iron deficiency and leaf tip chlorosis.

Pinching

One to Two Pinch is necessary. Do first pinching 2 weeks after transplant to promote branching
