SOWING: September to March

March through May if sown in fall

FINISHING: June through December if sown in winter

PHOTOPERIODISM Not daylength sensitive

PLUG STAGE:

TRAY SIZE: 288, 200

GERMINATION: Emergence 10 - 14 days / 65 – 70°F

SUPPLEMENTAL LIGHTING: Not required

PLUG FINISH: 5 weeks

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 24 – 30 days

DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER SOWING:

120- 180 days

TEMPERATURE: 50-80°F

PH: 6.8 - 7.0

COMMON DISEASE/PEST: Botrytis, anthracnose/Armyworm, aphids, mealy bugs, thrips, mites
